### Mini-dorm regulations in San Diego



City of San Diego "Mini-dorm" Regulations FACT SHEET

Mini-dorms are characterized as single-family homes that are rented out to multiple residents (usually students) at a time.

The second ordinance, the **Rooming House Ordinance**, was adopted by the City Council on April 15, 2008. The Rooming House Ordinance mandates that <u>landlords cannot rent out three or more individual rooms of a home under separate leases</u>. Additionally, rooming houses are only allowed as a permitted use in certain residential zones or commercial zones. It also only allows continued use of the property as a rooming house for three years (April 2011). Finally, with the exception of certain specified situations, the ordinance requires one parking space per tenant for all rentals that meet the criteria of a rooming house.




